### PRINCIPAL'S SOAPBOX

Here at Blockhouse Bay Primary School, one of our main goals is always to provide a wide range of educational experiences which help to excite and motivate the children. Recent sporting examples include interschool events for the older children in tennis, cross country, swimming, netball and gymnastics. We have also had a Futsal (small sided soccer) coach working at the school and I am sure that the children have enjoyed these games as well.

To supplement the children entertaining each other at assemblies, we have had a range of activities designed to raise their awareness of the performing arts. A high number of children have enjoyed taking part in optional lunchtime classes that have given them a taste of dances from around the world. These are then auctioned off which raises money for the school's fundraising targets.

### SOME THINGS TO CONSIDER ABOUT YOUR CONFERENCE IN TWO WEEKS TIME

Please make sure that you are <u>at the meeting venue on time</u>, as we do need to stick to the timetable. Late arrivals will have less time for their conference.

- If something unexpected happens and you cannot come, please let us know as soon as possible by phoning the office
- Please do not leave your child unattended at school when we close at 12.45pm, even if you have one of
  the earlier meeting times. Because of the conferences, no-one is available to look after the children in
  the playground.
- Please encourage other children to play away from the meeting venues if they are waiting for their siblings conferences to be completed
- If children are playing at school, we would expect that they would follow all of our usual school rules.
- If either party feels that more discussion is required, a further meeting time can be organised. Parents will receive their confirmed meeting times either through the email or in hard copy form. It is very unlikely that "on the day requests" for an appointment can be arranged for that day.

### **CARE 4 KIDZ SCHOOL HOLIDAY CARE**


