LOST PROPERTY

WHEELS AT SCHOOL

Riding bikes and toys with wheels can be great fun for children and can be great physical exercise. However, we do need to place some rules around this to ensure that all children and visitors to the school are safe:

- Parents are entirely responsible for children using toys with wheels and we accept no responsibility for their use either before/after school or at other times e.g. weekends.
- The riding of bicycles to and from school can only be done by Year 6 students and only after they have permission from the Principal. Bikes need to be placed in the rack at the front of the school and we strongly recommend that they are locked.
- Scooters and bikes can be used to travel to and from school but cannot be used on the grounds from 8.00am – 3.30pm
- We have nowhere to safely store property such as scooters, so parents leave them at school at their own risk.
- Skates or shoes with wheels cannot be used at school on school days from 8.00am - 3.30pm
- Parents may wish to provide safety padding/helmets etc. and to tell their children to wear them, but this is up to the parents to enforce.
- Only children who own the toys can use them at school.
